Page 1: OVERVIEW/OTORHINOLARYGOLOGY :

Otorhinolaryngology or Ear Nose Throat (ENT) is an Allied Speciality Subject in Surgical Branch for Third MBBS Students .It is a branch that deals with Medical and Surgical Management of conditions related to Ear Nose Throat including Head and Neck Regions. Patients seek treatment from otorhinolaryngology for diseases commonly affecting Senses and activities of Hearing,Speaking, Swallowing, Breathing , Eating etc.

Department of Otorhinolaryngology is the branch of Surgery at GMCH Nandurbar consist of 1 Unit with total 20 beds of 10 males and 10 females. A team of ENT surgeons are available who are specialized in the evaluation , diagnosis and treatment of full spectrum Ear Nose and Throat Disorders including comprehensive care of injured patients in casualties and Intensive Care Unit.

Department of Otorhinolaryngology provides well equipped technology such as Otomicroscopy Examinations, Diagnostic nasal endoscopy procedures , investigate with rigid fiberoptic laryngoscopy , pure tone audiometry , Tympanometry , OAE , BERA etc as Day care services apart from Routine Management of ENT Conditions such as FB Removal , Cleaning & Dressing and minor procedures .

The Department also takes active participation in dedicated organized camps at outreach centers like SDH, RH, PHCs to get specialist level care for early diagnosis and treatment and if needed refer to the main hospital for surgeries and procedures. Department also actively organizes awareness programs such as World Hearing Day , World Head and Neck Cancer Day , where events are organized in Mute and deaf schools where free distribution of Hearing aids and health checkups are done.

Department of Otorhinolaryngology in Government Medical College Nandurbar , Maharashtra focuses on overall development of students providing lectures, clinical postings with skill training and bed side clinicals to make them well trained medical professionals. - Assist/do independently basic E.N.T. procedures like ear syringing, Ear dressings, nasal packing removal of foreign bodies from nose, ear, throat.
- Assist in certain procedures like tracheostomy, endoscopies.
- Conduct CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation).
- Be able to use Otoscope, Nasal speculum, Tongue depressor, Tuning fork and head mirror etc .

INTEGRATION : The undergraduate training in E.N.T. will provide an integrated approach towards other disciplines especially Neurosciences, Ophthalmology and General surgery.
